The bill was then read a second time.

The bill entitled, an Act to provide for the selection, drawing and summoning of juries in the several counties, and prescribing their qualifications;

Being upon its second reading,

Mr. Carmichael proposed the following amendment:

In first section, line seven, strike out the words "first Monday in February" and insert "the third Monday in March;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Evans proposed the following amendment:

In line nine, strike out the words "first of September and the first of October" and insert the words "first Monday in August and the third Monday in August;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Carmichael proposed the following amendment:

In line 16 strike out the word "seventy" and insert "sixty-five;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Evans proposed the following amendment:

Strike out all after the word "misdemeanor," in the 19th line, to the word "and," next after the word "paid" in the 21st line;"
