Also, the petition of Daniel Emmert and other citizens of Washington county, praying the modification of the license law for District —, in Washington county; and asked to be discharged from the further consideration of the same.

The report concurred in and committee discharged.

Also, unfavorably on the petition of the Judge of the Criminal Court, and others of Baltimore city, in favor of the passage of a bill providing for the punishment of minor negroes; which,

On motion of Mr. Carmichael,

Was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Mr. Clarke, Chairman of the Committee on Claims, reported favorably the Senate bill, without amendment, entitled, an Act to authorize and direct the payment of claims due the members and officers of the General Assembly of 1861;

Which was read a second time, and,

On motion of Mr. Clarke,

Three fourths of all the members concurring,

By special order a third time, and passed by yeas and nays as follow :
