And be it enacted, That before the drawing of any new panel of Jurors from the tax lists and poll books, as provided in the first and second sections of this Act, it shall be the duty of the said courts to have the box in which the names of the Jurors have been deposited, to be emptied of any and all the ballots therein remaining;
