Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Susquehanna Hotel Company, in Port Deposit.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Maryland and New York Steam Transportation Company.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Mutual Fire Insurance Company of Somerset and Worcester counties,

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Miles River Wharf Company, at Miles river in Talbot county, passed at January session, 1864, chapter 46;

Which were severally read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to provide for the measurement of oysters in Baltimore city;

Which was read the first time and referred to the Select Committee on Oysters.
