Leave was granted the Talbot and Queen's Anne's county delegations, to introduce a bill entitled, an Act to repeal an Act entitled, an Act to authorize Mrs. Margaret Sherwood, wife of Hugh Sherwood, of Talbot county, to close a public road leading through his lands in said county, passed at the January session of the General Assembly, 1864, chapter 323,

Leave was granted the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, section 19 of Article 26 of the Code of Public General Laws in relation to corporations for selling, leasing and improving land.
