Leave was granted the Somerset County delegation to report a bill to be entitled, an Act to repeal section 39 of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the County commissioners for Somerset county, and to amend and re-enact the said section.

Leave was granted Frederick County delegation to report a bill supplemental to the Act of 1860, to build a turnpike from the Woodsboro' and Frederick Turnpike to and through the village of Mt. Pleasant to Libertytown, in Frederick county.
