Ordered, That Simeon Spicer, Delegate from Harford, on the 5th instant, voted for the bill entitled, an Act to authorize Acts of the Assembly, passed at the present session of the General Assembly, to be repealed and to make valid such repeal, under a misapprehension of the character and intent of the bill, and the House having refused to reconsider the vote to enable him to record his vote correctly, he desires it to be entered on the Journal that he is opposed to the passage of said bill, or any and all such system of legislation.
