Which was read and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Mr. Stevens (the rules being suspended) presented the following petition of Henry Barrett, of Baltimore city, an old soldier of the war of 1812, for a pension.

Which was read and referred to the Committee on Pensions.

On motion of Mr. Kraft,

Leave to introduce a bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Journeymen Plasterers' Association of Baltimore ;

Which was read and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

On motion Mr. Thomas,

Leave was granted the Committee Ways and Means to report a bill entitled, an Act to repeal section two of an Act passed February 7th, 1866, entitled, an Act to aid in the reorganization of St. John's College.

On motion of Mr. Neilson,

The House took up for consideration the bill entitled, an Act to provide for the erection of a new State Penitentiary, and to dispose of the present Maryland State Penitentiary ;

Said bill being upon a second reading ;

Mr. Lankford moved that the bill be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means ;
