Also, the bill entitled, an Act to repeal the Act of 1865, chapter 174, entitled, an Act relating to the registration of the voters of the State, and to enact other provisions relative to the registration of voters in lieu thereof.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to add a new article to the Code of Public Local Laws for Queen Anne's county, to build a new jail for said county, and to provide means for that purpose;

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to grant the sanction of the General Assembly to the bequest of Mary Hunt, of Baltimore county, to the Trustees of West Liberty Methodist Episcopal Church of said county.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Trustees of the Wesley Chapel Episcopal Methodist Church at Reisters-town, Baltimore county.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to allow mileage to the Trustees of the "Almshouse" in St. Mary's county.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to incorporate and to make a turnpike road from the town of Lietersburg to the town of Smithsburg, in Washington county.

Also, the bill entitled an Act for the relief of Nathaniel Duke, George W. Dowell, Thomas B. Billingsley and Richard Hance, administrators of William Billingsley.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Trustees of the Parsonage House of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Emmittsburg Circuit, East Baltimore Conference.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Chester River Fruit Packing Company.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to authorize the New Town Academy in Worcester county to sell their building and grounds, and to invest the proceeds of such sale in a building and grounds for a high school in the town of New Town.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of Caroline S. Newman, late of Queen Anne's county, deceased, to the stewards of the Methodist Episcopal church in Centreville, in said county.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to add an additional section, under the head of Hay and Straw, to article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled city of Baltimore, authorizing the erection of additional hay scales in the said city, and the purchase of a site therefor and the appointment of an additional inspector of hay and straw, and to regulate the compensation of inspectors of hay and straw.
