Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Also, a bill entitled, an Act to repeal the 232nd section of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Baltimore city entitled "Fines and forfeitures," and to re-enact the same with an amendment ;

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also, the bill entitled, an Act to add the following sections to Article 81 of the Code of Public General Laws, title, "Revenue and Taxes," sub-title, "Taxes," relating to the sale of real and leasehold estates for taxes in the several counties ;

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Also, a bill entitled, an Act to provide for the payment of costs incurred before Justices of the Peace, before appeal shall be heard, from their decisions ;

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also, a bill entitled, an Act to authorize Loudon Park Cemetery to make and enforce calls or assessments upon its capital stock ;

Also, a bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Maryland State Agricultural and Mechanical Association ;

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also, a bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the Methodist Episcopal Church, in Queen Anne's county, known as Ebenezer Church ;

Also, a bill entitled, an Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Somerset county to levy a sum of money to build a bridge over the Eastern Branch of the Wicomico river at Salisbury ;
