

Mr. Davis, of Baltimore city, proposed the following amendment:

Amend, after the word "dollars," in line 9, insert the words "one thousand dollars" for the Aged Men and Women's Homes;

Which was adopted.

Mr. Williams proposed the following amendment;

Section 1, title "Miscellaneous," after the word "dollars" in line 13, insert "for office rent and expenses of office of the Commissioner of Immigration, one thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary;

Which was adopted.

The bill, as amended, was then read a second, and by special order a third time,
