Which was not concurred in.

The bill entitled, an Act to repeal sections 3 and 4 relating to appeals from courts of law of article 5 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Appeals," and to re-enact the same with amendments;

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading, and made the order of the day for Thursday, March 21st, at 12 o'clock.
