The Committee of Conference of the two Houses upon the bill making appropriations for the support of the Government for the year ending on the 1st day of January, 1869, made the following report :

The Committee of Conference, to which was referred the General Appropriation Bill for 1868, beg leave to report that they recommend that the House agree to the first amendment proposed by the Senate. In the second amendment proposed by the Senate, insert in lieu thereof the following : "To the Assistant Librarian, four hundred dollars in addition to the \$600 now allowed out of the Contingent Fund for the Library."
