Ordered, That the State Librarian furnish the reporter of the Associated Press of Baltimore, on the floor of the Senate, with the same stationery supplied to the reporters in the House.

Ordered, That the Committee on Education be instructed to inquire what legislation is needed to enable the Boards of School Commissioners to keep the Schools in each County open longer than the six months per year required by Constitutional provision.

On motion of Mr. Ohr, it was

Ordered, That a Special Committee of five be appointed, to take into consideration the Article of the Code of Public General Laws, title Small Pox, and report such additions as may be requisite to make said Article more effective and beneficial in its operation, and report by bill or otherwise;
