Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to report a bill to revise and amend an Act entitled, an Act to incorporate the Queen Anne's and Kent county Rail Road Company, passed on the eighth day of March, eighteen hundred and fifty-six;

Leave was granted to the Committee on Finance to introduce a bill to repeal part of an Act of 1864, chapter 15, and amend the same relating to bounties of soldiers;
