Mr. Mules, from the Committee on Corporations, reported favorably a bill entitled, an Act to incorporate Clarksburg Lodge, No. 100, of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Mules, from the Committee on Corporations, to which was referred the bill entitled, an Act to incorporate the trustees of the Baptist Church at Jones' Mill, in Dorchester county;

Reported it without amendment,

The bill was then read the second time.
