

SCHOOLS—

Favorable report of a bill to authorize the levy of a sum of money to support the free public schools of the State, and to repeal section 1 of sub chapter 160, of January session, 1865, under the head of "Sources of Income," and first reading, 778, 818.

Senate bill to repeal section 4, chapter 3, Act 1865, chapter 160, entitled "School House Sites," and section 1, chapter 1, entitled "Sources of Income," first reading and referred, 825; favorable report and second and third and passed, 862.

Senate bill to alter, amend and add new sections to chapter 160, 1865, providing a uniform system of free public schools, first reading and referred, 848; favorable report and second, 1006, 1067; indefinitely postponed, 1118.

Petition for the repeal or modification of the present school system, 214, 273.
