TOWSONTOWN SAVINGS INSTITUTION—Leave to incorporate the, 109; favorable report and first reading, 219; second, 449, third and passed, 469; returned passed, 659.

TOBACCO—The Comptroller requested to inform the House whether the rents and profits arising from the State Wharves belonging to the Tobacco Warehouses was credited to the Tobacco Fund, 768; his response, 815.

The Comptroller ordered to report what money the State owes to the Tobacco Fund, 413; his response, 473.

Leave to reimburse the State Tobacco Inspectors for monies paid counsel in suits against them, 400.

Message to the Senate to appoint a Joint Committee to go to Baltimore to make a thorough investigation of the Tobacco Warehouses and the inspection of, 283, 316; petition against the sale of the Warehouses, 961.
