on the list which the Register furnished the Judges on the morning of the election, although it was in the list printed in the newspapers. Mr. Friend, the Register, came before the Judges, and told them that he had accidentally omitted to put my name on the transcript he had given them, and that he would correct the error, as my name had been legally registered in 1865, but the Judges refused to let the correction be made. I have never changed my residence since I was registered in 1865. The names on my ticket as candidates for House of Delegates were William Devector, John McElfish, William A. Bryden, George W. McCulloh and Patrick Hammil.
