Amend Section 1 by inserting the following in line 9, after the word "county:" Nor shall it be lawful for any person licensed to sell spirituous or fermented liquor, in the village of Charlotte Hall, to sell, dispose of, barter or give liquor of any kind, or in any quantity, to be drunk in any store, public place, or at any place within two miles of said village, other than a private dwelling.
