Amend 1st section, by inserting in the 4th line,, after the word "Laws," by inserting "title Anne Arundel county, sub-title Almshouse;"

In the 6th line, of the 1st section, after the word "be," add "re-enacted and."

Mr. Vickers, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, reported a bill entitled, an Act to make valid and operative in law a deed from Samuel Coe, to John A. Cox ;

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Vickers, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, an Act to add a new section to article 38, of the Code of Public General Laws, and to repeal certain sections of the Code of Public Local Laws entitled Bailiffs;

Reported it without amendment,

The bill was then read the second time.

Mr. Vickers, from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, to which was referred the House Resolutions, directing the Attorney General to examine into the affairs of the Baltimore and Frederick Turnpike Road;

Reported them with the following amendments:

After the words "and whether the said Pratt street road has been or is now in a condition such as their charter requires," insert "and whether their charter has been infringed in any other respect, due notice of which shall be given said company with specifications and opportunity to the said company for defence."

Also, after the words "if he shall be of opinion that the charter of said company in any or all of these," insert "or in any other particular."
