AN ACT to repeal the Act of 1862, chapter 106, and sections one hundred and ninety-four, to two hundred inclusive of the 30th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the sentence of negroes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, chapter one hundred and six, and sections one hundred and ninety-four, one hundred and ninety-five, one hundred and ninety-six, one hundred and ninety-seven, one hundred and ninety-eight, one hundred and ninety-nine, and two hundred, of Article thirty of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the sentence of negroes, be and the same are hereby repealed.
