In force. Sec. 8. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect and be in force from the date of its passage.

Repealed. Sec. 9. *And be it enacted*, That all laws inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 33.

Passed Feb. 18, 1867. *Entitled*, AN ACT to authorize Benjamin Norris and Elizabeth Norris, his wife, to convey by deed a tract of land to the party therein mentioned.

Authority to convey land. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Benjamin Norris and Elizabeth Norris, his wife, be and they are hereby authorized to convey by deed a tract of land containing thirty-one and a half acres to Martin John Spalding, Archbishop of Baltimore, for the use of the Pastor of St. Mary's Church, near Deer Creek, in Harford county.

Authority to hold the same. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said Archbishop shall be entitled to hold said land to the use of the Pastor of said Church, anything in the Constitution of this State to the contrary notwithstanding.

In force. Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
