

may think proper for services performed by their request, not exceeding fifty dollars per annum.

Sec. 34. *And be it enacted*, That the Mayor may remit any fine or penalty imposed under any ordinance of the Mayor and Common Council. May remit fines.

Sec. 35. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 49.

AN ACT to change the name of Benjamin Edes Long. Passed Feb. 12, 1867.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the name of Benjamin Edes Long of Baltimore, be and the same is hereby changed to that of Benjamin Long Edes. Name changed.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 50.

AN ACT to incorporate the Chestertown Water Company. Passed Feb. 21, 1867.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That George B. Westcott, Thomas W. Eliason, Richard Hynson, John T. Dodd, Jesse K. Hines, Charles Stanley, Henry W. Earnest, Joseph A. Vickers, Nicholas G. Westcott, John L. Stam, Wm. N. E. Vickers and William A. Vickers, of Chestertown, and all such persons as shall associate with them by becoming stock- Incorporated—power and privileges.
