

CHAPTER 57.

Passed Feb. 25, 1867. AN ACT requiring the County Commissioners of Prince George's county to construct a bridge across the Eastern Branch at Bladensburg on the turnpike leading to Washington, and authorizing them to levy a sum therefor.

Authority to build a bridge.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Commissioners of Prince George's county are hereby required and empowered to cause a good and substantial bridge for travel to be constructed under their direction across the Eastern Branch at Bladensburg on the turnpike leading to Washington; and to that end they are hereby authorized to adopt such plans and make such contracts and to do all other acts necessary for the erection and completion of said bridge.

Empowered to levy taxes.

Sec. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That the said County Commissioners of Prince George's county shall levy upon the taxable property of their county for the construction and completion of said bridge.

In force.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 58.

Passed Feb. 25 1867. AN ACT to repeal the nineteenth section of the twenty-fourth Article of the Code of Public General Laws, title Conveyancing, and to re-enact the same with an amendment.

Section repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the nineteenth section of the Code of Public General Laws, title Conveyancing, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the same
