

CHAPTER 60.

Passed Feb. 25, 1867. AN ACT to make valid certain bequests under the Will of Eleanor G. Scott, late of Baltimore city deceased.

Bequest declared valid. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction of the Legislature of Maryland, be and the same is hereby given to the following bequest in and under the Will of Eleanor G. Scott, late of Baltimore city deceased, that is to say, to the ladies Branch Bible Society of Baltimore, seventy-five dollars; to the Board of Domestic Missions; of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian church in the United States of America, seventy-five dollars; to the Board of Foreign Missions of the Presbyterian church in the United States of America, seventy-five dollars; to the Union Protestant Infirmary in the city of Baltimore, fifty dollars; to the Maryland Tract Society, auxiliary to the American Tract Society, seventy-five dollars; to the Sunday School Union, seventy-five dollars; to the aged Ministers Association of the Presbyterian church, seventy-five dollars; to Benjamin Franklin Scott of Lancaster county, Pennsylvania, four hundred dollars, in trust for the use and benefit of Little Brittan Presbyterian church, Falton Township, Lancaster county, Pennsylvania.

In forc. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 61.

Passed Feb. 21, 1867. AN ACT for incorporating the Andrew Small Academy of Darnestown, Montgomery county, Maryland.

Preamble. WHEREAS, application has been made to the General Assembly of Maryland for the passage of
