

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from and after the day of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 69.

AN ACT to authorize Acts of Assembly, passed at the present session of the General Assembly, to be repealed, and to make valid such repeal. Passed Mar. 5, 1867.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall be lawful for this General Assembly to repeal any Act that has been passed, or that may be passed, at the present session of this Legislature, and to pass another Act upon the same subject, and of the same form and substance of the Act thus repealed, and that any repeal of an Act passed since the commencement of the present session, shall be as valid and effectual as if the laws and usages of legislative bodies had authorized such repeal, and the re-enactment of the same by another Act. Lawful for the General Assembly to repeal and pass new Acts at same Session.

Sec. 7. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 70.

AN ACT appropriating the sum of sixty-one dollars and nineteen cents to pay the costs recoverable from the State, by the appellees, in the cases of State of Maryland *vs.* John Hartley, surviving obligor of James Twigg and others; and State of Maryland *vs.* Jonathan Hendrickson and others, said cases being appeals from the Circuit Court for Allegany county. Passed Mar. 4, 1867.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller be and he is Treasurer authorized to pay upon warrant.
