CHAPTER 72.

AN ACT to refund to L. T. Hyatt a certain sum Passed Mar. 4, 1867. of money erroneously paid into the State Treasury.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Treasurer authorized to pay and Maryland, That the Treasurer be authorized upon warrant. and directed, upon the warrant of the Comptroller to pay to the order of L. T. Hyatt, collector of State taxes, of the second election district of Montgomery county, the sum of seventy-seven dollars and six cents, erroneously paid into the State Treasury by the said Collector in the year eighteen hundred and sixty.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall In force. take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 73.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners Passe 4, 1867. Passed Mar. of Kent county to convey to Isaac Parsons and others, of said county, a portion of Old Crew's Landing, near the mouth of Sassafras river.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of convey land. Kent county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to convey unto Isaac Parsons, Henry T. Jump, James A. Rosebury, George Gale, Alexander Wilson, William Busick, Thomas J. Shellcross, and others who may unite with them, thirty feet front of the public landing at or near the mouth of Sassafras river, known as the Old Crew's Landing, in Kent county, the said thirty feet to be located at the lower or westernmost end of said landing.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the County Authorized Commissioners aforesaid be and they are hereby off.
