Amend 1st section, in line 3, after the word "laws," insert "of the city of Baltimore, sub-title, Lumber;"

After the word "follows," in line 5, add the word "section;"

The bill was then read the second time.

Mr. Vickers from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, an Act to pay A. Lingan Jarrett, the balance of his salary as late Comptroller of the Treasury,

Asked to be discharged from the further consideration thereof, and that said bill be referred to the Committee on Finance.

Section 19, And be it enacted, That the said Company shall start and run their cars for the transportation of passengers, and property at regular times, to be fixed by public notice; and shall furnish sufficient accommodation for the transportation of all such passengers and property, as shall, within a reasonable time previous thereto, be offered for transportation at the place of starting; and at the usual stopping places established for receiving and discharging way passengers and
