such other improvements as may be found or deemed necessary to give effect to the object and purposes of this Act, and to sell, rent, lease, convey, grant on condition or otherwise dispose of lands, water rights or water powers that shall or may become the property of said company, together with the buildings and improvements thereon erected, and the building and cpuipping of a steamboat or steamboats to ply on the waters of the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries between the said colony or colonies and the city of Baltimore, or any other point deemed necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act, for the purpose of towing and conveying freight, passengers and merchandize, for which said company may charge, receive and collect a reasonable compensation.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 86.

Entitled AN ACT to repeal sections eight, twelve, Passed Feb. 28, 1867. thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen and nineteen of an Act passed on the tenth day of March, eighteen hundred and sixty-four, and entitled An Act to incorporate The Maryland Life Insurance Company of Baltimore, and to re-enact in lieu thereof the following sections:

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections eight, twelve, thirteen, fourteen fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen and nineteen of an Act to incorporate the Maryland Life Insurance Company of Baltimore, passed at the session of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter three hundred and sixty-two, be, and the same are hereby repealed; and the
