CHAPTER 99.

*Entitled*, AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay John H. B. Latrobe, William Schley and and John M. Frazier for legal services. Passed Mar. 4, 1867.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay to John H. B. Latrobe, William Schley and John M. Frazier each the sum of one thousand dollars for legal services rendered the State in the investigation before the Governor of the cases of Samuel Hindes and Nicholas L. Wood, late Police Commissioners of the city of Baltimore. Treasurer to pay upon warrant.

CHAPTER 100.

AN ACT to incorporate the Trustees of the Baptist Church at Jone's Mills in Dorchester county. Passed Feb. 28, 1867.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Thomas Holland, George Lowe, Crain Hurley, William Holland, and Samuel W. Incorporated —power and privileges.
