

corporation hereby created as they may deem necessary, and the same may be altered in such manner as may be prescribed by said constitution.

Objects of incorporation.

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the object of the corporation hereby created is for the adoption and carrying out the rules of discipline of the yearly meeting of Friends held in Baltimore, as published by Armstrong and Berry in eighteen hundred and sixty, being their last Book of Discipline.

In force and reservation.

Sec. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and may be repealed, altered and amended at the pleasure of the General Assembly of Maryland.

CHAPTER 109.

Passed Mar. 7, 1867. AN ACT entitled an Act to change the name of Richard Dodson, of the City of Baltimore, to Richard Stearns Dodson.

Name changed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the name of Richard Dodson, of the City of Baltimore, be and the same is hereby changed to Richard Stearns Dodson.

In force.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
