## CHAPTER 118.

Passed Mar. 15, 1867. AN ACT, entitled an Act to incorporate the United States Real Estate Mining and Manufacturing Company of Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Darius C. Howell, William S. Raine, William H. Purnell, Henry Stockbridge, Matthew S. Gosnell, Milton Whitney, A. P. Gorman, William Cayton, Edward J. Chaisty, Jr., and John B. Armstrong, their associates and all and every person or persons hereafter becoming members of the United States Real Estate Mining and Manufacturing Company of Maryland, in the manner hereinafter mentioned, their successors and assigns, shall be, and they are hereby created and made a corporation and body politic by the name and style of the United States Real Estate Mining and Manufacturing Company of Maryland, and by that name shall and may have perpetual succession, and be capable in law of purchasing, holding, developing, improving and disposing of property, real, personal or mixed, in the manner and
