CHAPTER 148.

AN ACT for the re-payment out of the Storage and Outage on Tobacco, of monies heretofore demanded and received by the Inspectors of Tobacco, in violation of the Acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, Chapter three hundred and forty-six, and eighteen hundred and sixty-five, Chapter one hundred and ninety-four.

Authority to
re-pay.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the several Tobacco Inspectors in the city of Baltimore, be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to repay out of the moneys received by them, or to be received for storage and outage on Tobacco, all sums of money which have been improperly paid to them respectively, since the tenth day of March eighteen hundred and sixty-four, for storage of Tobacco in their respective Warehouses, before the same was sold by the grower thereof or his agent, in violation of the Acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter three hundred forty-six, and eighteen hundred and sixty-five, chapter one hundred and ninety-four.

In force.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from its passage.
