Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the Comptroller be authorized and required to examine into and adjust all the unpaid bounties under the said Act of Assembly of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter fifteen, entitled an Act to aid and encourage enlistments into the Maryland regiments in service of the United States," and the said Act of Assembly of eighteen hundred and sixty-five, chapter thirty-three, entitled, an Act to provide bounty for soldiers entering the service of the United States to fill the quotas of Maryland under the call of the President of the United States, of December, eighteen hundred and sixty-four and under future calls, and to issue his warrants to the Treasurer to be payed the same out of any unappropriated funds in the Treasury.

Treasurer authorized to pay upon warrant.

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the Comptroller shall from time to time issue his warrant to the Treasurer to pay out of any moneys in the Treasury for such sums as may be necessary to pay accruing and future interest on the bonds of the State which was issued under the said Acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter fifteen, and eighteen hundred and sixty-five, chapter thirty-three, hereinbefore referred to.

Comptroller to issue his warrant to pay future interest.

Sec. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the day of its passage.
