

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and required to issue his warrant to the Treasurer, and the Treasurer to pay the said amount of nine hundred and fifty-nine dollars and forty-seven cents to said agent to be distributed by him as aforesaid. Comptroller required to issue warrant.

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 164.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of costs incurred before Justices of the Peace before appeal shall be heard from their decisions. Passed Mar. 21, 1867.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That before any of the Circuit Courts of this State or the Court of Common Pleas of the city of Baltimore, shall proceed to hear or try cases brought to their respective Courts, by appeal from the judgments of Justices of the Peace, they shall first be satisfied that all costs incurred on the judgment and proceedings before the Justice aforesaid, shall have been paid by the appellant. Costs to be first paid.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

AN ACT to pay James Hopkins and Son for cleansing and restoring portraits of some of the early Governors of Maryland. Passed Mar. 23, 1867.
