CHAPTER 184.

AN ACT to repeal Article ~~seventy-one~~ of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, entitled Oysters, and to re-enact the same with amendments. Passed Mar. 23, 1867.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Article seventy-one of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, entitled Oysters, be, and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, to read as follows : Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That no owner, master, captain, hirer, borrower, or employee of any owner or other person shall use or employ any canoe, boat or vessel of any kind or description whatever in taking or catching oysters for sale in the waters of this State, or in buying or selling oysters in the State without having first obtained a license to so use or employ such canoe, boat or other vessel as hereinafter provided. Required to take out License.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury shall, upon the application of any resident of the State of Maryland, being the owner of any boat or vessel licensed or enrolled in any customhouse of the United States, in said State, issue to such resident license to take or Comptroller to issue License.
