

CHAPTER 213.

Passed Mar. 6, 1867. AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Worcester county to sell and convey a certain lot or parcel of ground in New Town.

Empowers
County Com-
missioners.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Worcester county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey to such person or persons, and upon such terms and conditions as they or a majority of them may deem just and proper, that lot or parcel of ground situate in the town of New Town in Worcester county, that was sold and conveyed by James Stevenson to William Schoolfield, John S. Stevenson and Ephraim T. Townsend as Trustees for the Levy Court of said county, on the twenty-eighth day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five.

In force.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* This Act shall take effect upon its passage.

CHAPTER 214.

Passed Mar. 6, 1867. *A supplement to* AN ACT to incorporate the Hillen Road Company of Baltimore county, passed at January session, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four, Chapter ninety-nine, and a supplement thereto, passed at January session, one thousand eight hundred and sixty, Chapter fifty-one.
