

spect shall continue, and the President and Commissioners, for the time being, shall continue in office until such election shall be held.

Sec. 6. *Be it enacted*, That the limits of said town shall commence at a stone set in the ground on the South side of the road leading from Warwick to Elkton, marked "third of Ask more," and running thence to the point in the middle of the main road, running from Warwick to Middletown, where the State line crosses said road; thence to a point in the middle of main road running from Warwick to the Levels, where said line crosses State road, thence to the intersection of the Head of Sassafras and Cecilton road, thence to the North-West corner of J. B. Morton's lot joining the land of J. J. Lockwood, thence to the place of beginning.

Limits of the Town.

Sec. 7. *Be it enacted*, That the said Commissioners or a majority of them may appoint a clerk, and prescribe his duties and allow him such compensation for his services as they may think proper.

May appoint Clerk.

Sec. 8. *Be it enacted*, That all ordinances passed by the said Commissioners or a majority of them, shall be entered by the clerk in a book to be kept by him for that purpose, and shall be open at all times for inspection of any person interested, and copies of all ordinances shall be set up in the most public places in said town, that the same may be generally made known.

Record of ordinances.

Sec. 9. *Be it enacted*, That the said Commissioners may pass all by-laws and ordinances necessary to give effect and operation to all the powers vested in the said Corporation, and to impose fines, penalties and forfeitures for the breach thereof; but no ordinance of said Commissioners shall impose a fine, penalty or forfeiture, for any one offence, of more than ten dollars.

Power of Commissioners.

Sec. 10. *Be it enacted*, That they shall have power to levy and collect taxes in said town, not exceeding in any one year thirty cents in the hundred dollars, on the the assessable property in said town.

Sec. 11. *Be it enacted*, That they shall once in three years or oftener if they think proper, ap-
