

the same generally upon the whole of the assessable property of said town or specially upon the assessable property of persons benefitted thereby.

Sec. 17. *Be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of Cecil County, may, at discretion, levy annually upon the assessable property of the County, and pay over to the said President and Commissioners the sum of fifty dollars, to aid in keeping the streets of said town, as part of the public roads of the County in good repair.

To levy tax.

Sec. 18. *Be it enacted*, That all taxes, fines, forfeitures and penalties, imposed by the said Commissioners by virtue of any law or ordinance, shall be applied for the use of the said town, as may from time to time by ordinance be directed.

Sec. 19. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 219.

AN ACT to incorporate the Monumental Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore.

Purcell, William Hopkins and John Small, Jr., the subscribers to the stock of the Company and their successors shall be and are hereby declared to be a body politic and corporate, by the name and style of the President and Directors of the Monumental Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore, and by that name shall have succession and be capable in law to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered, defend and be defended in all Courts of law and
