

## CHAPTER 227.

Passed Mar. 15, 1867. AN ACT to authorize Thomas Fawcett, of Montgomery county, to act as Postmaster and Justice of the Peace.

Authoriza-  
tion. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Thomas Fawcett, of Montgomery county, be and is hereby authorized to act in the double capacity of Postmaster and Justice of the Peace in Montgomery county.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 228.

Passed Mar. 13, 1867. AN ACT to incorporate the Trustees of the Parsonage House of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Emmittsburg Circuit, East Baltimore Conference.

Incorporation. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Joseph S. Waddles, Jacob S. Gelwicks and Frederick G. Meals, and their successors, be and are hereby declared to be a body corporate, by and under the name and title of the Trustees of the Parsonage House of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Emmittsburg, and under such name and title to hold the said parsonage house and lot of ground, and to have all such other powers as are or may be necessary to carry into effect this Act.

Powers. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said Trustees and their successors, by and under their corporate name, shall hold the said parsonage house and lot for the use of the several congregations now composing the Emmittsburg Circuit of the Methodist Episcopal Church, East Baltimore Conference, with full powers to sell and convey the
