Sec. 7. *And be it enacted*, That the objects for which this Company is incorporated are and are hereby declared to be, to purchase, hold, use, improve or sell and dispose of lands, tenements, rights, water privileges and easements of every description in the counties of the State of Maryland, or on any of the waters or water courses thereof, as the same are now and may by individuals be now bought, sold, held used or improved as the case may be under the law now in force in this State.

Increase of  
Stock.

Sec. 8. *And be it enacted*, That if the capital stock of said Company shall be deemed insufficient the President and Directors thereof, or a majority of them may from time to time, increase the capital stock to any amount not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars, for which increased stock they may at their option either cause subscriptions to be received in such manner as they may prescribe or may sell the same for the benefit of the Company.

Sec. 9. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and the General Assembly reserves to itself the right to alter, amend or repeal this Act at pleasure.
