AN ACT entitled an Act to repeal section thirty-nine, of Article nineteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the County Commissioners for Somerset County, and to amend and re-enact the said section.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section thirty-nine of Article nineteen of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the number of County Commissioners for Somerset County, be and the same is hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted, so as to read as follows :

Sec. 39. There shall be five County Commissioners for Somerset County, and at the general election for county officers to be held in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, in Somerset County, in addition to the County Commissioners to be elected at that election, under the existing law, two County Commissioners, herein provided for, shall be elected, and the three County Commissioners to be elected as aforesaid, at the said election; shall hold their offices for four years, and until their successors shall be elected and qualified.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
