

CHAPTER 256.

AN ACT to incorporate the Trustees of the Wesley Chapel Episcopal Methodist Church at Reisterstown, Baltimore county. Passed Mar. 22, 1867.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That William Dwyer, Johnsey Gardner, Jesse L. Bennett, Thomas K. Haughey, Elias C. Stocksdale, John H. Gore, Daniel B. Banks and Andrew Banks, and their successors duly elected as hereinafter provided, be and they are hereby incorporated as a body politic, under the name of "the Wesley Chapel Episcopal Church at Reisterstown, Baltimore county," with power to sue and be sued, to make a common seal, and change the same, to pass by-laws, to elect officers, and to hold real estate, not exceeding five thousand dollars in value, and to provide for the manner and time of the election of their officers, and the qualification of electors. Incorporated.

SECTION 2. *Be it enacted,* That the church property in Reisterstown now held by and for and used by the said Wesley Chapel Episcopal Methodist Church, be and is hereby vested in the said Trustees hereby incorporated. Property vested.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 257.

AN ACT entitled, "an Act to incorporate Wicomico Lodge, number ninety-one, of Ancient, Free and Accepted Masons." Passed Mar. 22, 1867.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Francis M. Slemmons, Worshipful Master, Ebenezer L. Wailes, Senior War- Incorporated.
