Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect and be in force from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 283.

Passed Mar. 13, 1867. AN ACT entitled, an Act to incorporate the Sassafras River Steamboat Company.

Incorporated.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Andrew Woodall, Alexander Wilson, John F. Wilson, Thomas J. Shallcross and Isaac Parsons, of Kent county, their associates, successors and assigns be and they are hereby created a corporation and body politic, by the name and style of the Sassafras River Steamboat Company, and by that name may have perpetual succession, and shall be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered in any Court of law or equity, and to make and use a common seal, and to do and perform all such other acts in relation to their business hereinafter declared, and to establish such by-laws and regulations as shall be necessary for conducting their affairs not inconsistent with the laws of this State or of the United States.

Objects of Corporation.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the objects of said corporation are a steam passenger and freight company, the bringing or building of steamboats, and such other articles as may aid in carrying on the said business in all its branches, and for which purpose they are authorized to rent, purchase and hold all necessary wharves, buildings, materials,
