

Sec. 20. *Be it enacted*, That nothing in this Act shall be so taken or construed as to allow the said corporation to issue any token, scrip or device to be used as a currency; and that the Legislature hereby reserves to itself the right to alter or amend this Act of incorporation at pleasure. Banking prohibited.

Sec. 21. *Be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect and be in force from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 297.

AN ACT to incorporate "the Frederick County Superphosphate and Manufacturing Company." Passed Mar. 15, 1867.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That George R. Dennis, Lawrence C. Bringle, Joseph Routzahr, Michael Reefer, John W. Binley, George Markell, Benjamin J. Snouffer, Lewis F. Detricks, Edward Jones, Joshua Biggs, Johnathan Routzahn, John B. Thomas, Henry Buzzard, Ezra Houck, John Loats, John A. Smith, Valentine S. Brunner, Aaron Anders, Singleton King, Outerbridge Horsey and their associates, successors and assigns, be and they are hereby created a Corporation and body politic, by the name and style of "The Frederick County Super Phosphate and Manufacturing Company; and by that name may have perpetual succession, and shall be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, to plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered, in any Court of Law or Equity, and to make and use a common seal, and at pleasure to alter the same and to ordain and establish such by-laws, and regulations as shall be necessary and convenient for conducting the affairs of the Corporation, not repugnant to law. Incorporated.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the objects of said Corporation are hereby declared to be the manufacture and preparation of super-phosphate, lime, com- Objects of incorporation.
