In force. Sec. 20. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Reservation. Sec. 21. *And be it enacted*, That the General Assembly reserves to itself the right to alter or amend this charter at pleasure.

CHAPTER 311.

Passed Mar. 15, 1867. AN ACT to change the name of John Francis Stack, of Caroline county, to John Rumbold Stack.

Name changed. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the name of John Francis Stack, of Caroline county, be and is hereby changed to John Rumbold Stack.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 312.

Passed Mar. 15, 1867. AN ACT to enable the Trustees of Middletown Academy, to transfer by deed the said building and grounds, to the Board of School Commissioners, of Frederick county.
