And be it enacted, That the Directors shall appoint a President, Secretary, and such other officers as shall be deemed necessary, who shall hold office for such time as the Directors shall appoint, and they shall make and ordain such by-laws and regulations as they may deem necessary and proper for the management of the business, and accomplishments of the purposes of the corporation; provided, that nothing therein contained shall conflict with the laws of the United States, or of the State of Maryland.
