Ordered, That the Comptroller furnish this House with the contracts and bills for printing the Laws, Documents, Bills and Journal of Proceedings of the Senate for the years 1858, 1860 and 1862.

On motion of Mr. Jump,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Jump, Stephenson Mackall, Vickers and Tome, to report a bill to incorporate the Cecil and Harford Counties Boom Company.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the Westminster Gas Light Company of Carroll county.
