CHAPTER 345.

Passed Mar. 15, 1867. AN ACT to incorporate Redemption Lodge, No. 1., Maryland, of the Independent Order of Good Templars of Keediesville, Washington county.

Incorporated. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Andrew V. Deaner, George C. Rohrer, and Jones S. Deaner, be and are hereby appointed Trustees of Redemption Lodge No. 1, Maryland of the Independent Order of Good Templars of Keediesville, Washington county, who are hereby made, declared, and incorporated, a body politic with succession in deed and law to all intent and purposes connected with the institution by the name and style of Redemption Lodge No. 1, Maryland, of the Independent Order of Good Templars, by which name and title they and their successors may sue and be sued, and have a common seal, and the same at their pleasure alter, and be entitled to have and use all the rights, privileges, franchises, and powers incident to such corporations.

May hold real estate. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said corporation shall be capable of taking and holding real and personal estate not exceeding fifteen thousand dollars.

No banking privileges. Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the said corporation shall not be permitted to issue any note, token, scrip, or other evidence of debt to be issued as currency.

Time for holding elections. Sec. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the time of holding the annual election for the said Trustees
